**ORDER GRANTING CHAPTER 11 TRUSTEE'S EX PARTE MOTION FOR
AUTHORIZATION TO CONTINUE TO USE THE DEBTORS' CASH PURSUANT TO
PRIOR CASH MANAGEMENT ORDERS**

The matter before the Court is the *Chapter 11 Trustee's Ex Parte Motion for Authorization to Continue to Use the Debtors' Cash Pursuant to Prior Cash Management Orders* (the "Motion"). The Court has considered the Motion and applicable law. Based thereon, and for good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- (1) The Motion is **GRANTED**; and
- (2) The Trustee is authorized to continue to use the Debtors' cash pursuant to the Cash Plan (defined in the Motion) until the earlier of (a) the time when the Court has entered orders relating to the Trustee's substantive consolidation motion and plan of liquidation; or (b) April 1, 2013, at which point the Trustee will either file another motion or schedule a hearing with the Court relating to the Trustee's continued use of the Debtors' cash.
