Robert D. Geringer ("Geringer"), through his undersigned counsel, hereby submits this Surreply to the Trustee's Reply (the "Reply Brief") in Response to Robert D. Geringer's Opposition to Joint Motion for Summary Judgment and for Distribution of Interpleaded Funds [Docket No. 154], and respectfully states as follows:

In the Reply Brief, the Trustee argues that Mr. Geringer's opposition to the
 Trustee's summary judgment motion was untimely. The Trustee is mistaken in this

argument because through an email exchange between the undersigned counsel and

the Trustee's counsel, it was agreed that Mr. Geringer would be granted an indefinite

extension to respond to the Trustee's summary judgment motion, which would terminate

two weeks after the date of a mediation between the Trustee and Mr. Geringer. A copy

of this email exchange is attached as Exhibit 1.

2. As of the date of that email exchange, September 3, 2015, the date of the

mediation had not been fixed. Subsequently, the mediation was scheduled for

November 4, 2015. Unfortunately, the mediation was not successful.

3. In the meantime, on September 28, 2015 the Court fixed a hearing on the

Trustee's summary judgment motion for November 12, 2015. Although Mr. Geringer's

extension granted by the Trustee would not expire until November 18, 2015, Mr.

Geringer filed his opposition to the Trustee's summary judgment motion on October 23,

2015, in order to ensure that it would be on file well in advance of the scheduled

hearing, in the event that the mediation did not result in a settlement.

4. Accordingly, Mr. Geringer's opposition to the Trustee's summary judgment

motion was timely because it was filed before the expiration of the extension to respond

that had been granted by the Trustee's attorneys.
